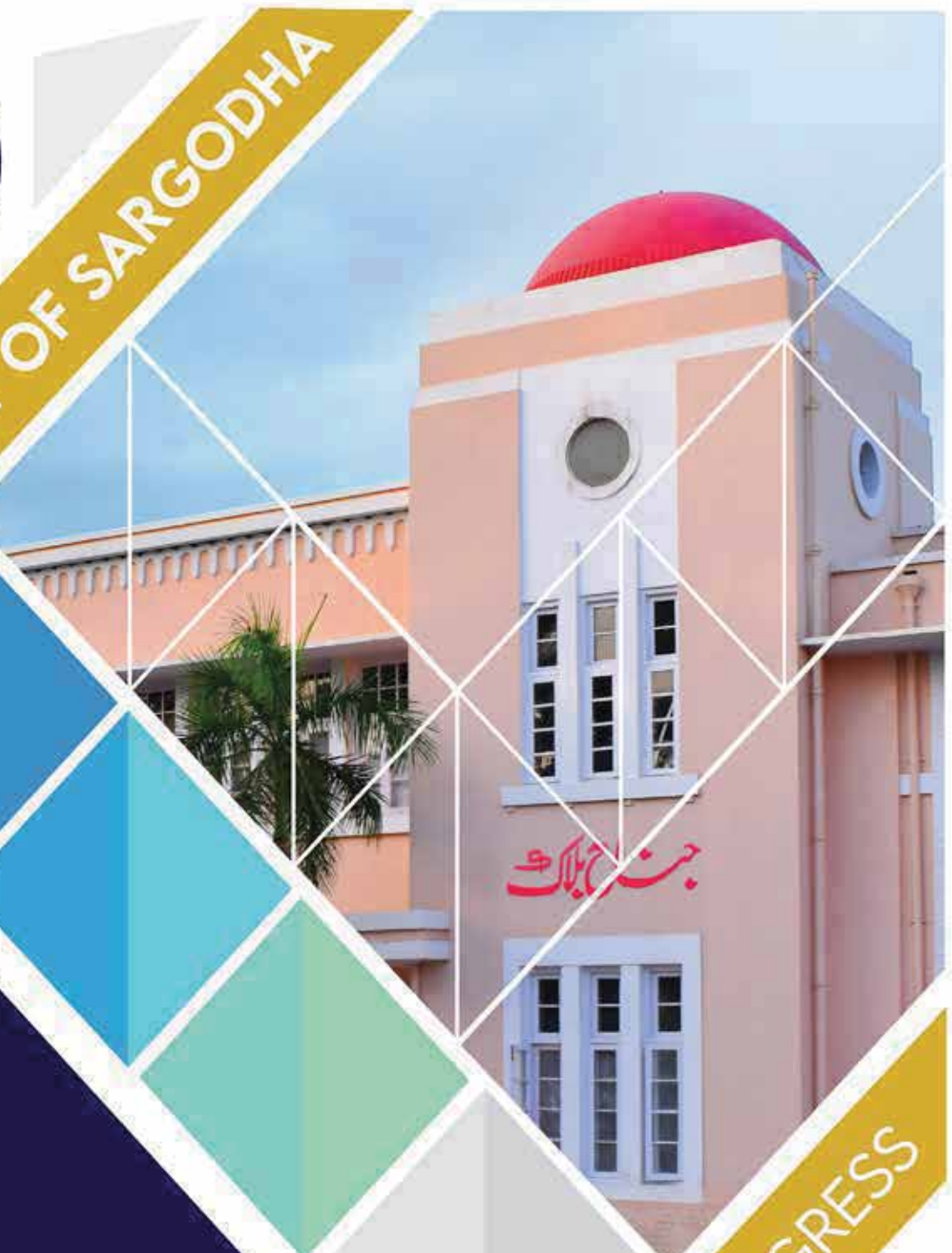

WELCOME TO UNIVERSITY OF SARGODHA

We are proud to introduce the University of Sargodha as a major public sector University in the province of Punjab, Pakistan. The University of Sargodha started its journey as O'Brien Islamia High School Shahpur, established in 1916. It was named after the Deputy Commissioner Shahpur, Major A. J. O'Brien, who sanctioned the school. The establishment of the school was laid by B.T. Gibson, the Deputy Commissioner, Shahpur in 1916. In 1929, it was taken over by the government and was converted into Government College. Later on, in 1932, graduate classes were started in the college. The college was renamed as De Montmorency College Shahpur after the visit of the Governor of Punjab, Jeffery De Montmorency in 1934. In 1946, the college was moved to Sargodha partially due to the efforts of the business community of Sargodha because Sargodha was comparatively more developed than Shahpur. The college was again renamed in 1963 as Government College Sargodha. It was awarded university charter in 2002 by then Governor of Punjab Lieutenant General (R) Khalid Maqbool.

Since then, the University has emerged as one of the Pakistan's leading seats of advanced studies and research in computing & information technology, business and economics, arts and humanities, natural and social sciences, law, agriculture, pharmacy, medical and health sciences and engineering and technology. With its main campus located in Sargodha city and Agriculture college in its suburb, the University presently

has around 22,000+ on-campus students and 570 faculty members, including 300+ PhDs, in 40 departments, four institutes, one school, and four constituent colleges that come under the eight faculties including faculty of Social Sciences, Sciences, Pharmacy, Medical & Health Sciences, Engineering and Technology, Computing & Information Technology, Arts and Humanities and Agriculture. They are assisted by around 1,700 administrative staff. The University also has 200+ affiliated government and private colleges spread across the province.

Its main campus, located in the heart of Sargodha city, is green and serene. The University prioritizes the promotion of critical learning and scholarship among its students and young faculty. Each semester, it remains abuzz with a variety of scholarly, co-curricular and sports activities, including seminars and conferences, job fairs, business ideas competition, sports gala and literary festival. The University offers modern teaching and research facilities, including well-equipped classrooms, laboratories, and a vast collection of library material with online access to books and journals. Over a dozen hostels accommodate all female students, a limited number of male students and state of the art hostel for the international students as well. With an affordable fee structure, the University provides a host of scholarships, internships and business opportunities to the needy and meritorious students.

To ensure productive research, the University has established vibrant institutions, including the Office of Research, Innovation and Commercialization, and Quality Enhancement Cell, and Waheed Wain Incubation Center, which have helped to register the several international patents for faculty in sciences and agriculture, besides funding research projects and publications and linking academic research with the local economy. The University runs a Citrus Nursery and produces its own mineral water, KhusAab, for faculty, staff and students. It also has a strong tradition of community service, with its University Medical Complex and Research Centre offering OPD, pharmacy and diagnostic services to university students and staff as well as the people of the city.

The University has an ambitious agenda of quality-centric academic growth in the foreseeable future. It ultimately aims to become a hub of higher education in Pakistan and South Asia
