

OUR INITIATIVES

In order to accomplish the objectives of establishing PICS at Sargodha University, the following initiatives are taken:



Confucius Institute at SU

Sargodha University hosts fifth Confucius Institute (CI) in Pakistan. Hanban (Confucius Institute Headquarters) is a non-profit public education organization affiliated with Ministry of Education of the People's Republic of China whose aim is to promote Chinese language, culture and people to people contacts through cultural and education exchanges. CI at Sargodha University will significantly contribute in terms of learning Chinese language, culture and offering opportunities to the students and faculty for further studies in China.

Academic Linkages with Chinese Universities

PICS facilitated a MoU between Sargodha University and Henan Normal University signed on 13 July 2019. Under provisions of the MoU, the two universities agreed to establish a Confucius Institute at Sargodha University, exchange of faculty and students, joint research, split-degree programs etc. Negotiations with some other Chinese universities are in progress.
