The University of Sargodha (UoS) expanded its global engagement through high-level visits and strategic collaborations. As a key outcome of the partnership, both institutions jointly inaugurated a Lithium Battery Research Centre, a state-of-the-art facility dedicated to advancing energy storage technologies and fostering applied research. The initiative represents a major milestone in UoS's commitment to expanding research-based industrial collaborations with Chinese institutions.

Looking ahead, the agreement's next phase outlines the establishment of a joint Lithium Battery Manufacturing Unit in Pakistan. This development is expected to enhance industrial-academic linkages, support technological innovation, and build local capacity in one of the world's fastest-growing tech sectors. Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Qaisar Abbas led the UoS delegation, accompanied by Prof. Dr. Ijaz Asghar Bhatti, Director External Linkages, and Prof. Dr. Tahir Mumtaz Awan, Director of the Pakistan Institute of China Studies and Host Director, Confucius Institute at UoS. mitment to long-term cooperation in scientific research, vocational training, and technology-driven development. The partnership underscores a deepening Pak-China academic alliance and positions UoS as a key contributor to cutting-edge innovation in sustainable energy solutions.


UoS Delegation Briefs Pakistan Consul General in Guangzhou on Proposed Overseas Campus

UoS Signs LOI to Establish First-Ever Pakistani **Overseas Campus in China**



The University of Sargodha (UoS) has signed a Letter of Intent (LOI) with the Changjiang Li Autonomous County Government in Hainan Province to establish a joint overseas campus—the first initiative of its kind by any Pakistani university in China. The LOI was formalized during an official ceremony attended by Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Qaisar Abbas and Chief Mayor of Changjiang Li, Mr. Liang Ming. Both sides affirmed their commitment to fast-tracking the project through close and sustained collaboration.




Ahmad Khan Haral distributed food supplies and essential goods to 760 families in these severely affected areas.





Prof. Dr. Qaisar Abbas also outlined major advancements in research and innovation, including the establishment of a fully operational Interdisciplinary Research Center for One Health, a joint laboratory with Zhejiang A&F University, China, a commercial lab testing facility, and a Business Incubation Center. Highlighting transformative infrastructure projects, he noted the launch of a 2.7 MW campus-wide solarization project, a new data center, an upgraded central library, and UoS Web TV, soon to expand into a satellite channel.

Significant international collaborations were also highlighted, including a state-of-the-art hospital and boarding school in partnership with China, the launch of UoS's first overseas campus in Hainan Province, China, and the joint Lithium Battery Research Centre with Zaozhuang School of Technology, China.
