The decisions made during this historic session reflect a visionary approach by UOS in research, innovation, and commercialization, promising a transformative impact on the university's academic landscape.

#### Training Sessions To Facilitate Professional Development

## 6th International Conference On Pure And Applied Mathematics

The Department of Mathematics UoS organized the 6th International Conference on "Pure and Applied Mathematics 2023" (ICPAM), to disperse greater acquaintance of the latest trends in the field of mathematics. Academics, researchers, professionals, and practitioners from around the world gathered at the two-day conference on December 6–7, organized in partnership with the Punjab Higher Education Commission and Pakistan Science Foundation, to share and discuss research findings, experiences, and practical issues.

The conference concluded with many sessions on various tracks of pure and applied mathematics in which young scholars also presented their research work, supervised by senior professors and researchers.
