- 8. No one is allowed to leave the Examination Hall before first one hour is over. If anyone leaves after one hour or before half the time is over, he/she shall not be allowed to take away the Question Paper.
- 9. Un-authorized change of Center is strictly prohibited. If anyone changes his/ her Center of Examination on his/ her own, Un-fair Means Case will be registered against him/her. Similarly no change of subject is allowed unless permitted by the University.
- 10. No one can appear in the Examination without getting his/her Roll Number Slip. Unfair Means Case will be registered against those who violate the instructions and rules/regulations of the University.
- 11. The candidates are not allowed to bring/use mini computer/calculator and mobile telephone sets in the Examination Hall. Unfair Means Case shall be registered against those who violate the above or such other instructions as are issued.
- 12. The candidates must reach examination center at 1:30 pm. No candidate will be allowed to enter examination hall after 2:00 pm.
