

Important Instructions for the Candidates.

1. Roll No. should be written on the right of the title page of the Answer Book only and not at any other place. Answer Book number should also not be mentioned inside the book.
2. Marks of identification should not be made any-where in the Answer Book or on the title page.
3. Do not bring material relevant to the syllabus before entering into the Examination Hall.
4. Do not make appeal to the Examiner in the Answer Book.

6. Do not disobey Center Superintendent, change your Roll No / Seat with any other candidate,
